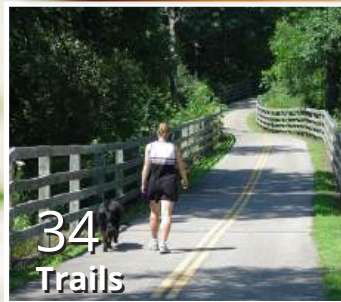

COOLEST THING MADE IN IOWA

Vermeer

"The Coolest Thing Made in Iowa showcases the best of Iowa manufacturing," said Mike Ralston, ABI President. "Congratulations to all of this year's finalists and especially to the entire team at Vermeer."

The Iowa Association of Business and Industry (ABI) the 2024 contest winner was the ZR5-1200 self-propelled baler, manufactured by Vermeer Corporation in Pella. Iowa's manufacturing industry contributes roughly \$38 billion to the economy annually and employs over 225,000 Iowans.

Vermeer was founded in 1948 and is headquartered in Pella, Iowa. Vermeer is a family-owned and -operated company with team members, regional offices and dealers around the world. Vermeer revolutionized haymaking with the ZR5-1200, the world's first self-propelled baler that reduces the steps needed to make a bale and maximizes productivity through zero-turn capabilities.

"My grandfather was a farmer. He founded Vermeer on a spirit of innovation by simply searching for a better way to do hard work. Receiving this award is incredibly special as it indicates his legacy continues on," said Mindi Vanden Bosch, Vermeer Vice President of Operations. "I am proud of the cool equipment we build and even more proud of the team who designs, builds and supports it. 180th Marion County, Iowa

Marion County, Iowa was officially approved by the State of Iowa on June 10, 1845 and named after General Francis Marion, a legend from the Revolutionary War. When Marion County was first organized, the area was divided into five voting precincts: Knoxville, English, Cedar, Red Rock and Lake Prairie. For the first three years, county operations took place in a six square foot cabin owned by L.C. Conrey.

In 1848, a courthouse was built for county offices at a cost of \$600. The building was 24 feet wide by 30 feet long. By 1858, Marion County experienced population growth and a new two-story brick structure was constructed for county operations. The cost of the 48 feet by 70 feet structure was \$17,500. This building was condemned in 1895 when serious structural problems were discovered. In a special election on May 14, 1895, voters approved building a new courthouse. The current courthouse was opened on December 30, 1896.

The architect of the current courthouse was Mifflin E. Bell who also worked on the Iowa Capitol and the Washington Monument. The courthouse lawn includes markers honoring the Iowa flag, Red Rock Line and several war remembrances. 2025 marks the 180th anniversary of Marion County.

90th Pella Tulip Time Festival

The Pella Tulip Time Festival began in 1935 as a one-day event to celebrate the town's Dutch heritage. The first Tulip Time included a locally written operetta, but no tulips, parade or queen. In 1936 the event was expanded to five days including tulips, parade and a queen.

Today, the three-day festival is coordinated by Pella Historical Museums and features 2 daily parades, thousands of tulips, Dutch dancing, market and great food. Many in the town still today can trace their roots back to Dutch ancestors. 2025 marks the 90th anniversary of the first Tulip Time.

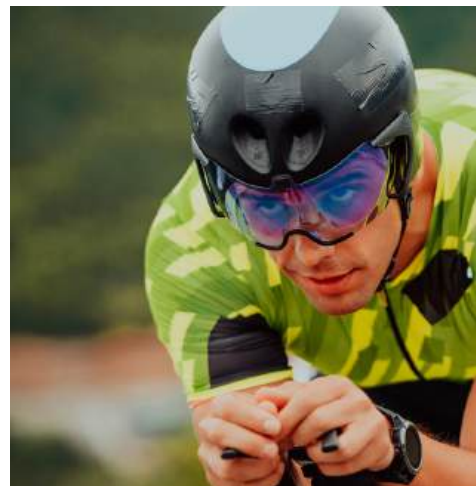
Water **FUN**

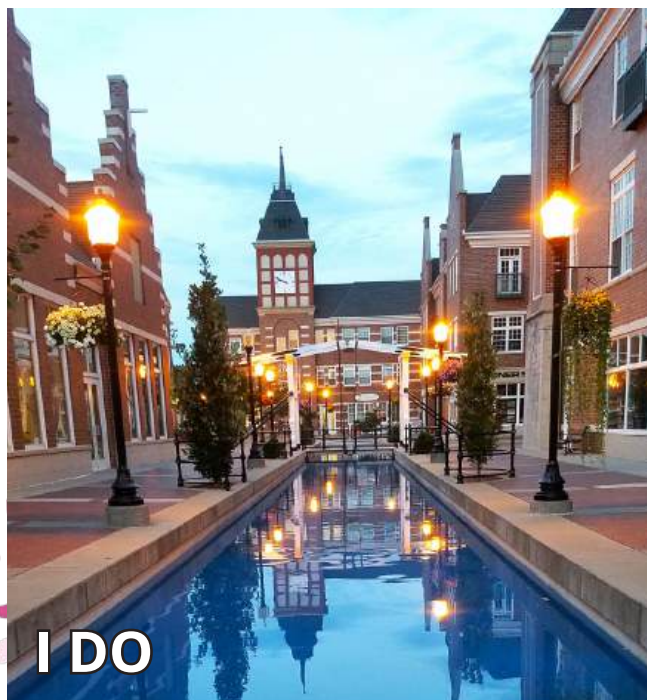

ICONIC LOCAL IOWA FOODS & WHERE TO FIND THEM...

The Red Rock area and Iowa have some great local foodie items that you must try when visiting...just like fish boils in Door County, gulf shores seafood and California wines.

PORK TENDERLOINS

WHAT ARE THEY? It is the lean tender boneless meat from a pig's back. It is served grilled or breaded.

WHERE TO FIND THEM? Northcote Meats & Locker-Halftime Bar & Grill-Checkerboard Restaurant-Hometown Meats & Deli-Kone Korner-Butcher's Brewhuis

CORN ON THE COB

WHAT ARE THEY? An ear of sweet corn that is cooked and eaten right off the cob. It can be boiled, steamed, roasted or grilled.

WHERE TO FIND THEM? Stands start popping up after the 4th of July and the season runs until early August. Popular locations to find this yummy item is Dan-D Farms in Knoxville and the local farmers markets in Pella. Many of the grocery stores sell local grown corn.

GAS STATION PIZZA

WHAT ARE THEY? In Iowa, many of the gas stations also double as pizza places for take out or some with delivery. The quality is way beyond a frozen pizza and many also make a Taco Pizza which is popular in the region.

WHERE TO FIND THEM? They can be found at Casey's and Kwik Star.

DUTCH BOLOGNA

WHAT ARE THEY? A cooked ring of bologna which is a smoked & cured sausage with special seasonings.

WHERE TO FIND THEM? You can purchase Dutch bologna in local grocery stores, but there is nothing like going into In't Veld Meat Market or Ulrich Meat Market to see the wide variety of meats they make.

MOREL MUSHROOMS

WHAT ARE THEY? A wild mushroom which can be found in forrest areas in spring all around the Red Rock area.

WHERE TO FIND THEM? You can hunt for mushrooms in the public park areas at Lake Red Rock.



SCOTCHEROOS

WHAT ARE THEY? Dessert bars with chocolate, butterscotch, peanut butter and Rice Krispies.

WHERE TO FIND THEM? They can be found at Hy-Vee-Fareway-Butcher's Brewhuis,

DUTCH LETTER

WHAT ARE THEY? This flaky puff pastry is filled with almond paste and then staped into the letter "S".

WHERE TO FIND THEM? They can be found at Jaarsma Bakery-Vander Ploeg Bakery-Smokey Row-food stands during Tulip Time.

POFFERTJES

WHAT ARE THEY? They are a sweet tiny little Dutch buckwheat pancake traditionally topped with butter and powdered sugar.

WHERE TO FIND THEM? They can be found at Clover Leaf on Franklin year round or at food stands during the Tulip Time Festival.

Visit the Hall of Fame dedicated to legends within the sprint car racing industry. Located just off Lincoln Street in Knoxville.

Opa's Barn

See tools used in early pioneer days. Located just west of Pella on G-28.

Peace Tree

Visit the Peace Tree at the Red Rock Marina to learn about early Native American history in the area.

Vermeer Museum

Learn about innovations in agriculture & construction at the Vermeer Museum on the east side of Pella.

Wyatt Earp House

Inside the Pella Historical Village is the boyhood home of western legend Wyatt Earp.

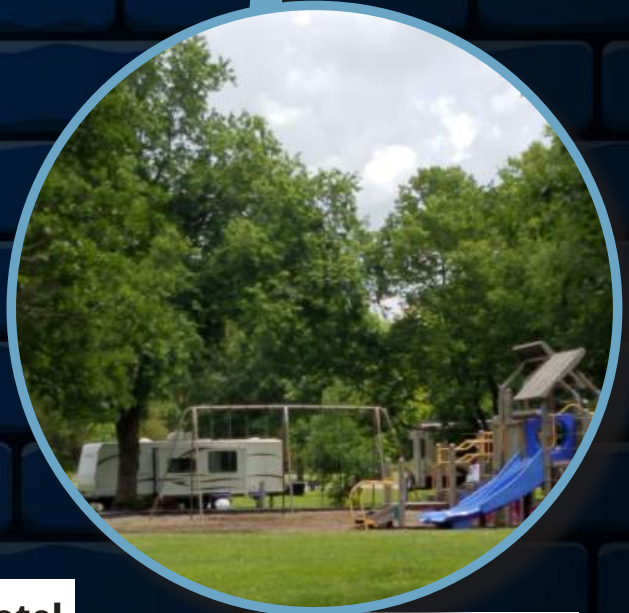

Jaarsma Bakery

Jaarsma Bakery has been offering Dutch treats since 1898. Harmon Jaarsma brought recipes with him when he immigrated from Holland and had two brick ovens in the bakery that were fired with wood. After the ashes were brushed out, the bread was put in to bake, followed by the buns, Dutch letters, cookies and rusks. Back then, the Dutch letters were made only as a special treat for Sinterklaas Day. Harmon's son Frank learned the business of baking from his father and in 1948 moved the bakery to its present location on Franklin Street in downtown Pella. In 1973, a fire burned the bakery to the ground. Frank's two sons, Howard and Ralph, built a new bakery on the same site. Today, the bakery is owned and operated by Harmon's great-great-granddaughter Lisa and her husband Carl.

LAKE RED ROCK

Located between Knoxville and Pella, Lake Red Rock is Iowa's largest lake with over 35,000 acres of public

land to explore. Great campgrounds and trails provide multiple opportunities to connect with nature. Spring and fall migration brings thousands of birds into the area. Beginning paddlers and crappie anglers should check out Roberts Creek located next to Lake Red Rock. Climb to the top of the Cordova Tower to get a view of the entire valley or snuggle in to enjoy s'mores around the campfire.



CORDOVA PARK

Cordova Park is named after the town of Cordova which was platted in 1887. It had several businesses, but remained small. Cordova Park is not only home to the observation tower, but also has a great earthen trail to explore the cliffs. If you need restrooms, stop by the new Cordova Office to recharge. Cordova Park is home to three sizes of rental cabins featuring modern restrooms and kitchen. These cabins are available to rent year-round and provide a great way to spend time with family. The Cordova Pavilion has hosted reunions, weddings and corporate retreats.



Lake Red Rock was built by the US Army Corps of Engineers back in the 1960's as a flood control project on the Des Moines River. The lake is comprised of 15,000 acres of water. Lake Red Rock collects runoff and drainage from a 12,320 square-mile area in Iowa and southern Minnesota.

CAMPING is one of the most popular activities at the lake. Parks and campgrounds around Lake Red Rock are managed by **three different park agencies**: US Army Corps of Engineers, Iowa Dept. of Natural Resources and Marion County Conservation Board. This is important to keep in mind when making reservations since they each have separate systems.

Hickory Ridge offers a unique hike-in or paddle-in campground. This area offers a primitive experience to stay overnight in the wilderness.

MUST DO activities include a stop at the **Red Rock Visitors Center** to learn about programs going on during your stay and pick up information on the lake area. Next, travel to Cordova Park to climb the **Cordova Observation Tower** for a birds-eye view of the entire valley. While there, check out their information center and enjoy the Karr Nature Trail.

Take in some rays at the **North Overlook Beach** or **Whitebreast Beach**. These two beaches provide a relaxing way to gear down and enjoy a summer day. Check out the **Red Rock Archery Range** or **Roberts Creek Disc Golf Course** if you want to add some action to your vacation experience.

BIRDERS visiting in spring and fall should plan a stop just below the dam to see migratory birds of all types. In the winter months, the area is home to hundreds of bald eagles.

TRAILS around Lake Red Rock provide a great opportunity to put in a workout in nature. The



41-mile **Lake Red Rock Water Trail** features a "sea cave" and upclose view of the cliffs. A couple great places to access the water trail are the Elk Rock Boat Ramp, Red Rock Marina or Cordova Boat Ramp. Paddlers also enjoy Roberts Creek which flows into Lake Red Rock and SUP Red Rock offers paddleboard rentals at this location.

The 17-mile paved **Volkweg Trail** starts at Cordova Park and extends along the north side of Lake Red Rock through Roberts Creek, Fifield, Wallashuck and North Overlook. The trail then goes on the other side of the dam to Howell Station and Ivan's before traveling into Pella. There are a couple cool bridges and you can take a break at the Playscape near North Overlook to let the kids play.

Equestrian camping and trails are available at Elk Rock State Park. The facilities include horse stalls, hitching rails, equestrian was station and riding arena.

PELLA



Visitors to Pella are transformed to the cobblestone streets and architecture of the Netherlands. Dominie Scholte and a group of almost 800 immigrants from the Netherlands set sail for America in April 1847 on four ships. They settled on lands between the Skunk and Des Moines rivers. Today, Pella is a vibrant industrious town which reflects the Dutch roots of many residents.

The Pella Tulip Time Festival is a three-day event held each spring. The town also hosts events throughout the year including a Dutch Christmas market in early December, antique car show in July and Thursdays in Pella in June and July on Thursday evening.

DOWNTOWN Pella includes the **Klokkenspel** which features eight 4-foot mechanical figures. On the north side of the square you will find **Scholte House Museum & Gardens**. This home was built by Pella's founder. In the center of downtown is the **Tulip Toren** which is the location for entertainment for many of the outdoor events. On the square you will also find a smaller information windmill which is a great place to find out what is going on during your visit.

MUST DO activities for history lovers include a stop at the **Pella Historical Village, Scholte House Museum, Pella Opera House** and **Vermeer Museum**. In the summer, the **Pella Acquatics Park** and **Wonder Spelen Park** are great locations to entertain kids.

Central College located just south of downtown offers Division III sports events and performing events throughout the school year.

FOODIES will enjoy checking out the two local meat markets in downtown: **In't Veld Meat Market** and **Ulrich Meat Market**. Here you will find Dutch spiced meats and other Iowa made products. Also downtown are two Dutch bakeries: **Vander Ploeg Bakery** and **Jaarsma Bakery** in addition to **Cranberry Stone Bakery** which makes cupcakes and **The Bread Board** which specializes in sour dough bread.

Relax and enjoy the unique atmosphere at downtown bars. **The Assylum** is a rooftop bar at Butcher's Brewhuis. The **de Kelder Speakeasy**, recipient of an Iowa Tourism Award for excellence,

PELLA HISTORICAL VILLAGE

Located a block east of downtown, the village includes the Vermeer Windmill, miniature Dutch village, boyhood home of Wyatt Earp, sod house and much more. This is a must-do stop on your visit to Pella. Here you can learn about the history of Pella and get some great souvenirs at the gift shop. PellaHistorical.org



is located in the basement near the Klokkenspel. **Nederlanders Tap & Golf** offers simulated golf and great bar food. The **Cellar Peanut Pub** has three times won the award of best beer bar in Iowa and twice their Bloody Marys have won at the New York Wine & Food Festival with the Food Network.

Manufacturing is alive in Pella. Local manufacturers include **Pella Corporation, Vermeer, Precision, Inc., Lely North America,** and **Ring-O-Matic**. Stop in at the PACE Alliance offices or Visit Pella, both are located just northwest of downtown to learn about career opportunities in the area and housing. You may just want to make your visit permanent!

PLEASANTVILLE, MELCHER-DALLAS & MORE!

Marion County was named after General Francis Marion who was an American Revolutionary War hero from South Carolina. When dragoons first explored the Des Moines river valley in 1835, they found a timber belt along the river nearly 4 miles wide and prairie grass growing over six feet tall. The Sac and Fox tribes made their homes along the river and in 1845 the Red Rock Line

opened settlement into much of western Iowa.

Rural Marion County features small towns brimming with great foods, fun gathering spots and charming downtowns. Special events throughout the year provide opportunities to mix with the locals.

FOODIES Today, one of the best ways to enjoy rural Marion County is to sample some of the homemade flavors. In Melcher-Dallas, make sure to get some giant pork tenderloins at **Northcote Locker & Meats**. If you are looking for a nice stop on a road trip around the area, plan a stop at **Nearwood Winery** just south of Knoxville for some wine or visit the original **Smokey Row Coffee House** in downtown Pleasantville for a cup of locally roasted coffee. While in Pleasantville, go across the street to **Checkerboard Restaurant** to experience their onion rings and corral pies (pizza). It is a one-of-a-kind restaurant who has received honors as a top rural restaurant by the Iowa Tourism office.

COAL During the early history of the county, coal mining was king with over 500 coal mines once operating in the area. **Melcher-Dallas** still celebrates their coal mining heritage with an annual event in June and museum.

MUST DO activities for rural Marion County include a stop at **Pierce's Pumpkin Patch** in the fall, **Dan-D Farms** for sweet corn & sunflowers, **Marsh's Gardens** for flowers and **Nunnikhoven Farms** for spring tulips or fall pumpkins. **Opa's Barn** just west of Pella is an amazing spot to learn about woodworking's history.

WEDDING VENUES

The Gathering Grounds and Countryside Wedding & Event Center are both located in southeast Marion County and provide an amazing venue for weddings, retreats, reunions and meetings. In addition, Nearwood Winery located south of Knoxville also has wedding reception facilities.

Around the globe, one place is the crown jewel for sprint car racing...the Knoxville Raceway. At the airport, you will find the home of the Des Moines Skydivers which provides another thrilling experience. Downtown you will find fun bars and restaurants to unwind from a thrilling day.

HISTORY The City of Knoxville was founded in 1845 and named to honor General Henry Knox who was a revolutionary war hero. Today, Knoxville is known as the sprint car capital of the world. Learn about the history of big car racing at the **National Sprint Car Hall of Fame & Museum**. Racing events occur each week from mid-April until the end of September.

MUST DO On the lawn of the historic **Marion County Courthouse**, you will find a marker paying tribute to Dixie Cornell Gebhardt who was the creator of the Iowa flag. On the west edge of Knoxville, you will find the **Marion County Historical Village** where the past is celebrated and **Marion County Park** which is a great campground. Inside the park, you will find a covered bridge which makes a great photo spot and pond which has a fishing dock.

THRILLS abound at **Slideways** where you can try your skills racing go-karts that look like sprint cars or enjoy a round of mini-putt. Step up your thrill seeking a couple notches by heading to the Knoxville Airport to skydive. The **Des Moines Skydivers** make Knoxville their home and you can book a time to jump.

SIP a great craft beer downtown at **One Eleven Public House** and then travel to the east side of the downtown square to sip a martini at **A & P Pub**. ...And if you want to enjoy downtown longer take in a movie at the **Grand Theater** and book a stay at the **3rd & Main** vacation rental above A & P Pub.

VA DISTRICT is being redeveloped into housing. This 150-acre area was the home to the VA Hospital from the 1920's to the 1990's. This unique redevelopment project was made possible through a partnership between Marion County and the City of Knoxville. This is also the site for the new Splash Pad.

SPLASH PAD

The VA District features a new Splash Park which is great for kids to explore. The water features can be activated between 9 am to 9 pm seven days a week by pressing the button on the blue bollard.

This feature is open seasonally.

Restrooms are open during hours of operation.

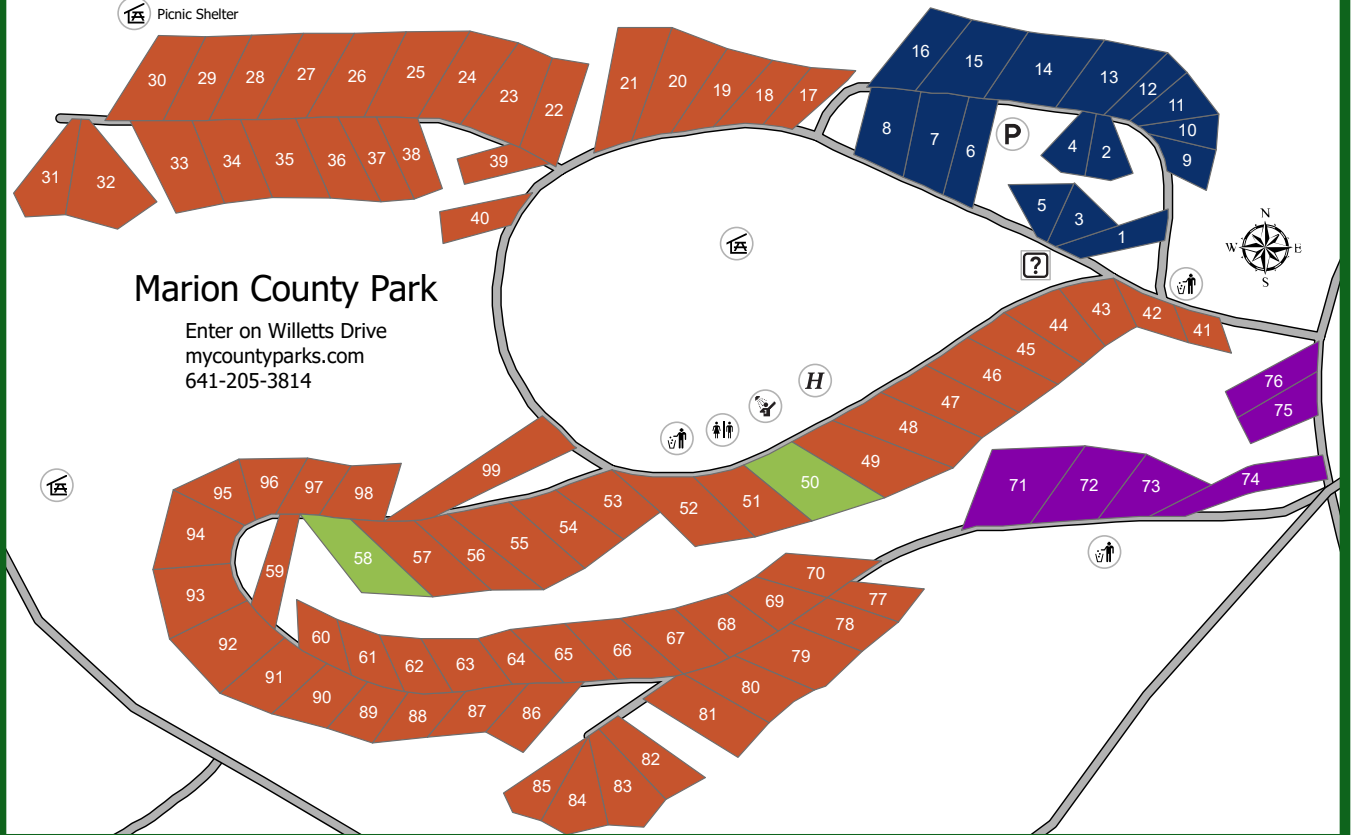

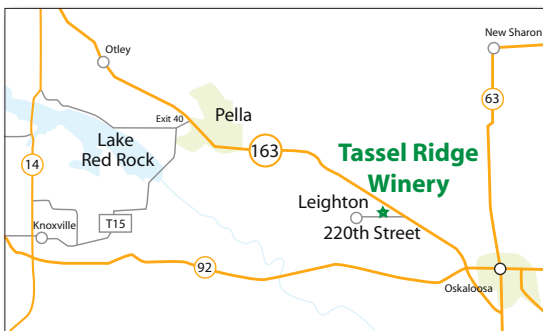

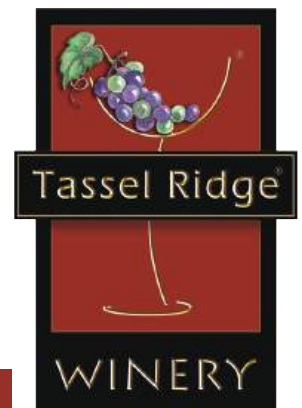
